Miss Milgram is choosing to use her Scholarship towards a year to study abroad in Jerusalem at Amudim. The seminary program provides a rigorous learning program and a supportive religious environment.

When awarded the Scholarship, Miss Lopatin commented, “I am so incredibly honored to be receiving the Hilda Specter Morgenstern Merit Scholarship. I hope to channel Mrs. Morgenstern's inspiring life and work into my year in Israel and everything I pursue after that. I am so excited to spend a year in Israel learning and growing in my advocacy and as a person, with the help of the Hilda Specter Morgenstern Scholarship.”

The Advisory Board, made up of Mrs. Morgenstern's three daughters, were impressed by Miss Milgram's dedication and passion to her studies and her community service.
